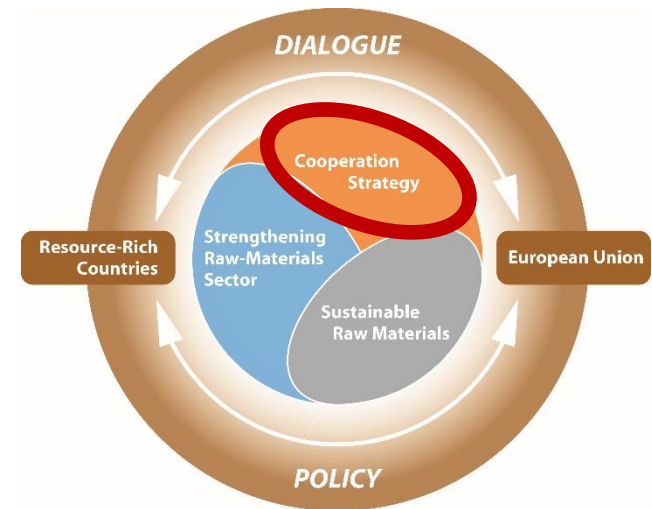
Main topics:

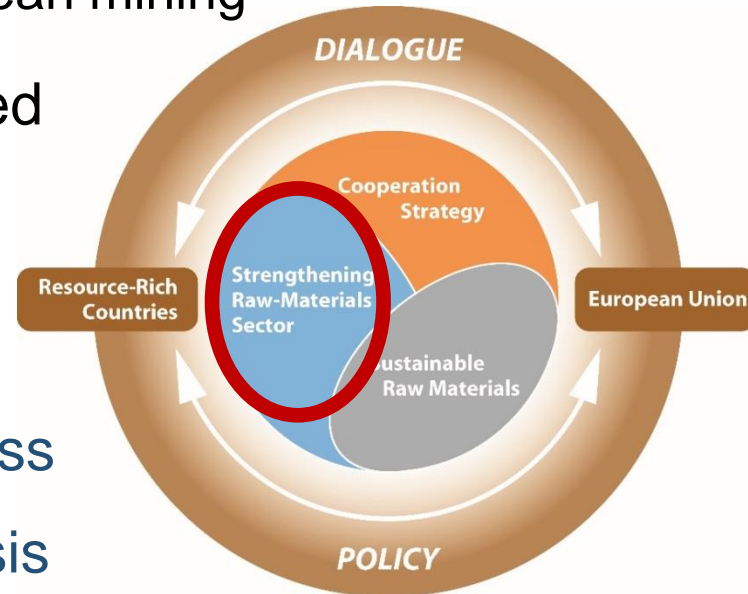

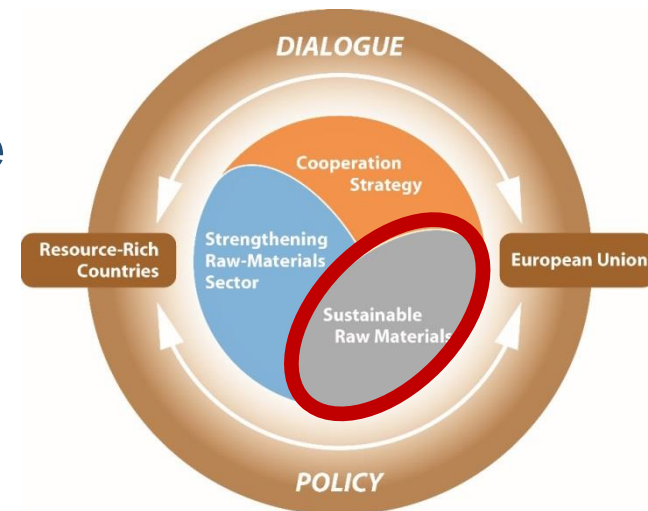
